Sampler 3

Twelve 12" blocks will be presented with a lesson featuring specific quilting techniques. This sampler can be done by a beginner but also offers options for more challenge for the advanced quilter. Stay and sew the block or take it home. **Start ANYTIME \$6.00 / month \$7.00 / month for batiks**
