##### **Moda's Bakers Dozen**

Thirteen pieced blocks from Moda's designers use three fat eighths each. Two setting options are available. You choose your color scheme and fat eighth cuts each month. Just let us know what you would like so we have it available. (Actually there are 15 blocks so that if you do not like a couple blocks you can substitute ones you do like. )

Here are some examples -reds, whites and blues / black, tan, and creams from Primitive Gatherings / anything in Kansas Troubles / anything in Me & My Sister brights / dark blue, light blue and white.....

1) Come in and pick up your pattern and recipe anytime during the month 2) have them mailed, or 3) Come in the 1st Fridays at 9:00 or 3rd Tuesday at 6:30 for demo and/or sit and sew time

\$5.00 per month includes 3 fat eighths, pattern and recipe

**Cora Jo's Circle** This is a queen sized quilt designed from original 30's patterns given to me. There are 12 blocks plus a center block. You can opt to make a smaller quilt if you leave out the center block. Blocks use three different 1/4 yard pieces OR leftover pieces from previous blocks.

1) Come in and pick up patterns anytime each month, 2) have them mailed OR  
3) attend class demo and/or stay and sew the 2nd Tuesdays at 10:30 or the 3rd Saturdays at 2:00.

\$2.00 per pattern or \$20.00 paid in January for all of the patterns. Individual patterns can be purchased each month if you want just specific blocks. You will need to purchase the background and setting fabrics. Kits and 1/4 yard cuts will be available each month but feel free to use from your own stash too.

### **FIVE CONTINUING SERIES**

**Buck a Block Thangles Series 8** This is a real deal. For \$1.00 you get two 3" strips of fabric and a pattern each month (for 12 months). Just come in each month with your finished blocks and pick up the next month's strips and pattern. Kits are available for making these blocks into a quilt 67" by 97". Please see website for suggestions or stop in and make up your own fabric combination. This began in November but it is not too late to start now.

**Sampler 3** is designed for beginners or those who wish to brush up on their quilting techniques. Lessons can be taken monthly, weekly or whenever it fits into your schedule. Sampler 3 also offers a more challenging option if desired. You may choose your own color scheme if you wish. \$6.00 per block includes fabric and class

**Calendula Patterdrip** - Piece some blocks and add some embroidery using Cosmo variegated thread. Full payment for pattern, thread and stitchery fabric is required the first month. Additional fabrics are needed and may be purchased all at once or as you go along. Crayons are also needed. Option: pick up the whole thing at once rather than do a block a month

**Class 1st Tuesdays of month at 1:00 or 6:00.**

**CIVIL WAR CLUB 2 -- Begins anew in January 2012.**

Each month, rotary cut pattern directions are given to make Civil War era 6", 9" or 12" finished blocks with a lecture about Civil War history /Civil War era fabric history. A piecing demo is included with show and tell time of finished blocks and quilt projects. Once a year, a guest speaker is invited. Make however many blocks you wish. Additional fabric is available and needed for background and finishing. Civil War Club 2 options include repeating blocks done the past 3 years from *Civil War Love Letters*, continuing with blocks not done yet in *Civil War Love Letters*, and/or *Path to Civil War*.

Meetings are held the **last Thursday** of the month at 10:30 (except November and December due to the holidays) *Civil War Love Letters* (discount on book purchase offered to club members) or *Path to Civil War* book required

\$10 includes 2 fat quarters of your choice, pattern and lecture

**Farmer's Wife Club Last Saturday of month 9:00**

Join anytime. Use your stash to make blocks from the Farmer's Wife book. Instructions given that avoid templates if at all possible. Meets the last Saturday of the month at 9:00.

**Folding Wallet** - Make a folding wallet with vinyl insert and many pockets. 1st session - cutting and organizing pieces OR do at home before class 2nd session - sewing. I LOVE mine because all essentials fit in a small mini-purse.
